# **EVENT PLANNING TIPS:**

The Rental Place provides the very best **tents for weddings**, corporate and social events. Below are a few tips to determine how to calculate space for dancefloors, tents and tables.

### HOW TO DECIDE ON THE RIGHT TENT SIZE FOR YOUR WEDDING

The Rental Place offers **Frame Tents** which are free standing structures that can go on grass, concrete, asphalt, decks, and rooftops. They do not have poles that come down on the interior of the tent. The aluminum poles are visible in the interior roof of the tent, however that can be covered by one of our beautiful tent liners.

You will need to determine what type of event you are having. The following is the approximate number of square feet you will need per person based on the type of event you are having.

## DANCEFLOOR SIZING

In general, if you are having an event for 100 people, the rule of thumb is that no more than 50% of the total number of people will be dancing at one time. So, if you are having a party for 100 people then you should use a  $15 \times 15$  dance floor because it has a capacity of 50 people. (This, of course, is only a rule of thumb. You know your guests better than we do. So, feel free to go with a smaller or larger dance floor based on your guests.)
